

AWARDS

1. Exhibits in all classes will be placed by judges in purple, blue, red, and white categories. Purple awards or rosettes will only be awarded where there is sufficient quantity and quality.
2. Premium checks will be mailed to 4-H Community Leaders or FFA Advisors after the fair to be dispersed to exhibitors. Checks not cashed in 120 days from date of check will be NULL/VOID and not reissued or available.
3. Premiums are not paid in fitting and showing classes for any animal species. Showmanship classes will be offered in beef, sheep, swine, dairy, dairy goats, meat goats, dogs, and horses. At the discretion of the Superintendents showmanship classes may also be offered in rabbits and poultry.
4. Livestock bedding and materials must be removed from stalls and pens at the close of the fair or premiums will not be awarded to exhibitors.
5. Not following rules and direction of Division Superintendents and /or Fair Representatives will result in forfeit of premiums.
6. Purple ribbons do not indicate eligibility for the State Fair. That determination is only made at county fair level.
