Special Rules

1. Read general rules
2. All dairy exhibits must be in place by 11 am Thursday, with the exception of lactating dairy cows, which may be entered the day of the show and released the same day.
3. All animals entered in this division must be stalled together in the north livestock barn in the place designated. Straw must be furnished by owner.
4. Age in the following dairy classes will be determined by standard classification.
5. Animals shown in this division may be either purebred or grade, but club members are strongly urged to show purebred animals
6. Each exhibitor must present proof of ownership of his/her animal or animals as of May 1 of current year.
7. Champion rosettes are awarded only if animals entered are considered championship quality by the judge.

Dairy Breed Champions

Open to first and second blue ribbon winners in individual breed classes. Rosettes may be awarded to the champion and reserve champion Ayrshire, Guernsey, Holstein, Jersey, Milking Brown Swiss and Milking Shorthorn. Champion rosettes are awarded only if animals entered are considered championship quality by the judge.

A champion dairy animal trophy will be presented to the winner.

Fitting and Showing

Fitting and showing classes will be offered before or after other classes at the discretion of the judge.

Junior division – Exhibitors 7-9 years of age as of Jan 1 of the current year.

Intermediate division – Exhibitors 10-13 years of age as of Jan 1 of the current year.

Senior division – Exhibitors 14 years of age or older by Jan 1 of the current year.

Participants awarded ribbons only, no premiums.

A trophy will be presented to the overall champion.

Top two compete in round robin showmanship contest.
