Special Rules

1. Read General Rules
2. All swine must be penned in the swine barn.
3. All breeding gilts must have been farrowed after February 1 of current year. Papers are required on breeding livestock.
4. Both barrows and gilts will be eligible for the breeding class.
5. In individual breed classes (market or breeding), three entries are required to form a separate class. If there are not three animals entered, those animals will be judged in the same class with the crossbred or other breeds animals.
6. Exhibitors that plan to check out early need to inform swine superintendent at check-in.

7. Market swine weighing under 200 lbs will show as light weight and be ineligible to compete in the grand drive.

Grand and Reserve Grand Champion Market Hogs

Open to first and second blue winners in preceding market swine classes. A trophy will be presented to the grand champion market swine.

Pen of Three Class – Club

Clubs may enter as many pens of three market swine as they have entered in the fair. The swine must be fitted and exhibited by club member owners. An entry card must be provided for the class at check-in. The top three entries will receive club awards of \$10 for first place, \$7.50 for second place and \$5 for third place.

Pen of Three Class – Individual

Individual pen of three owned and shown by one exhibitor. Must be represented by at least two breeds. An entry card must be provided for this class at check-in, with 4-H/FFA identification

numbers on it. The top three entries will receive cash awards of \$10 for first place, \$7.50 for second place and \$5 for third place.

PeeWee Division – Exhibitors 6 years of age and under

Junior division – Exhibitors 7-9 years of age as of Jan 1 of the current year.

Intermediate division – Exhibitors 10-13 years of age as of Jan 1 of the current year.

Senior division – Exhibitors 14 years of age or older as of Jan 1 of the current year.

Participants awarded ribbons only, no premiums.

A trophy will be presented to the overall winner.

Top two compete in round robin Showmanship contest.
