Rabbits

Judging: 12:00 p.m. Thursday

1. Read general rules.
2. All rabbits must be on the grounds and in place by 11:00 a.m. Thursdays.
3. Judging will be based on classes, weight schedules and breed specifications as outlined in the current "A.R.B.A. Book Of Standards."
4. Only first 4-H rabbit project members may enter crossbred animals. Rabbits in these classes will be judged on individual merit. Entries in this class are not eligible for champion awards. (No crossbred classes offered at State Fair)
5. All exhibitors should be present to carry rabbits to the judging table.
6. All rabbits are to be tattooed (left ear). Note: Tattooing will be available from 8a.m. to 11a.m.
7. Any rabbit determined to be ill will be removed from the show.
8. Exhibitors must bring their own feed, as well as water and feed dishes. Exhibitors are responsible for the care of their own entries.
9. Rabbits must be owned by exhibitors 30 days prior to the show.
10. Each exhibitor will be limited to two (2) animals per class, per breed.
11. In classes where only one exhibitor makes entries, furnishing his/her own competition, only one premium will be awarded, determined by the judge.

Showroom Classes

Class 190 – Senior bucks (8 months and older in breeds having an intermediate class, 6 months old in all other breeds).

Class 191 – Senior does (8 months and older in breeds having an intermediate class, 6 months old in all other breeds).

Class 192 – Intermediate bucks, 6 to 8 months.

Class 193 - Intermediate does, 6 to 8 months.

Class 194 - Junior bucks, under 6 months.

Class 195 – Junior does, under 6 months.

Class 196 – Pre-junior bucks under 3 months old. (Not eligible for premiums).

Class 197 – Pre-junior does under 3 months old. (Not eligible for premiums).

Meat pen

Class 198 – Meat pen (This includes three rabbits of the same breed and variety, all less than 70 days old and a minimum of 3 pounds and a maximum of 5 pounds in weight each. A meat pen is considered one breed entry)

Fur

Class 199 - Fur entries: normal white fur, normal colored fur, Satin white fur, Satin colored fur, Rex white fur, Rex colored fur, Angora white fur, Angora colored fur. Must be in showroom class.

Champion and Reserve Champion Rabbit Exhibit

Open only to top blue entries. Rosettes awarded at the discretion of the judge.

Showmanship

Showmanship classes may be offered at the discretion of superintendent and judge.

Note:

Classes of pre-junior apply only to the following breeds: Beveren, Californian, Champagne, D 'Argent, American Checkered Giant, American Chinchilla, Cinnamon, Crème D 'Argent, Flemish Giant, New Zealand, Palomino, Satins and Silver Fox.

Classes of intermediate apply only to the following breeds: American, Beveren, Californian, Champagne, D 'Argent, American Checkered Giant, American Chinchilla, Cinnamon, Crème D 'Argent, Flemish Giant, New Zealand, Palomino, Satins and Silver Fox.
