Dogs

Special Rules

1. Read general rules.
2. Dogs must be on grounds and checked in with superintendent one-half hour prior to show time and will be released immediately after showing.
3. Dogs are not allowed to roam at-large on the fairgrounds at any time. No dogs allowed in the livestock barn area.
4. Members are required to train their own dogs but may be assisted by 4-H leaders or family members.
5. Dogs in season will not be allowed to show.
6. The "Guidelines for Kansas 4-H Dog Shows" Handbook will be used as a source of show requirements.
7. Immunization records are required. Vaccinations to include: distemper, bordetella, hepatitis, parvovirus, parainfluenza and rabies. The rabies vaccination must be administered by a graduate, licensed veterinarian. All vaccinations must be current.
8. Abuse of dogs will not be tolerated at any time. Dogs must not be left unattended at any time.
9. Owners should collect all dog waste in plastic bags and put in trash.

Obedience

Class 220 – Sub-Novice A: first-year handler and first-year dog. (Heel and figure 8, stand for examination, recall, 1 minute sit stay, 3 minute down stay, ALL ON LEASH)

Class 221 – Sub Novice B: For handler that did not qualify in Sub-Novice A in previous year; experienced handler and 1st year dog; or experienced dog and 1st year handler (All exercises same as above)

Class 222 – Novice Under 10: For youth too young for State Fair competition. Exercises the same as for Novice A and B.

Class 223 – Novice A: First-year off-leash for dog (Heel and figure 8 on leash. Stand for examination off leash, heel free, recall off leash, 1 minute sit stay off leash, 3 minute down stay off leash.)

Class 224 – Novice B. Experienced handler with 1st or 2nd year dog, or those not qualifying in Novice A in previous year. (All exercises same as Novice A)

Class 225 – Graduate Novice. For those receiving a qualifying score in Novice A or B in previous year. (Heel on leash, heel free and figure 8 off leash. Stand for examination off leash, drop on recall, 3-minute sit stay out of sight)

Class 226 – Open A: For those who have qualified in Graduate Novice in prior year.

Class 227 – For those who have qualified in Open A in prior year.

Showmanship

Junior division – Exhibitors 9-11 years of age as of Jan 1 of the current year.

Intermediate division – Exhibitors 12-14 years of age as of Jan 1 of current year.

Showmanship will be judged on fitting of dog: clean and well brushed, tone and condition of coat, healthy appearance, teeth, toenails, eyes and ears. Handler will be judged on alertness, grace and ease, coordination with dog and reaction of dog to handler with straight and even gait and movement of dog.

Ribbons will be awarded, but no premiums paid in showman-ship classes
