Judging: Refer To The Schedule In Fair Paper

1. Read general rules. 'All exhibits must be entered by 11:00 a.m.
2. Entries may have been used before exhibited, however, items should be carefully laundered or cleaned before exhibiting.
3. Labels: A label containing name, address, county, and class shall be type written on 1"X3" white cotton tape, sewed to the article on the underneath side near a corner or edge. In case of furniture, etc., a paper label of the same size is to be asked or tied to the exhibit. Each piece making up an exhibit must carry a label.
4. 4-H'er may enter any combination of exhibits, with no more than two entries per class.
5. Poster or notebook may include swatches, colors, stories, photographs and project records which detail what was accomplished this year, with an indication given of a long-term plan.
6. Educational Poster or Display Poster must be no larger than 22"X28" poster board. Displays are not to exceed a standard commercial 3'X4' tri-fold display board.
7. Educational poster, display or notebook may include swatches, colors, photographs, and project records which detail what was accomplished this year with a given indication of long-term plans.

Single Exhibit

Exhibit an article made by the 4-H'er for the home. Include explanation of how it was made, cost, pictures, plans, patterns, etc. Explanation can be made on a poster, in a story, or other method. (If a pair is exhibited, include both)

Class 360 - Single exhibit

Class 361 - Original single exhibit. Create own design and pattern. Also include a statement as to how you used the design elements and principles in creating your original exhibit.

Class 362 - Poster. (Not to exceed 22"X28")
