### **Arrangements (Must be grown and collected, rather than purchased)**

**Class 422** – Arrangements (specify use for arrangements)

**Class 423** – Arrangement using dried plant material (no fabric or plastic allowed)

**Class 424** – Potted Flower or Plants

**Class 425** – Terrariums

**Class 426** – Cactus

### **Single Stem Class**

**Class 427** – Houseplant, foliage, or flowering (Houseplant must be cared for by the exhibitor for a minimum of 6 months)

**Class 428** – Single Stem Annual

**Class 429** – Single Stem Perennial
