Miscellaneous Exhibits

Judging: Refer To The Schedule In Fair Paper

1. Read general rules.
2. Entries must be made and complete at the time of the being entered (Thursday 11:00a.m. (deadline))
3. The make-up of entries will depend entirely on the 4-H member' own imagination and interpretation. Members should provide written explanation where exhibits are not self-explanatory.
4. Among other things, exhibitors should consider neatness, appearance, educational value, originality, promotional ideas, and overall quality.
5. If a display box is used, the standard entomology box (18"X24"X3 ½") is the suggested maximum size; however, larger displays will be accepted as long as space permits.
6. If posters are used, 22"X28" standard poster paper is the maximum size. Card tables may be used, if exhibitors provide them. Maximum Tri-Fold size is 3'X4'. (Standard 8' folding tables will be available).

Class 600 - Hand pets (larger animals should be housed in the rabbit barn or areas better suited. (Please get with Division Superintendent for assistance if needed). The project will still be judged by the Miscellaneous Judge.

Class 601 – Miscellaneous Exhibits.

Class 602 – Exploring 4-H/Clover Bud (limited to crafts, hand pets, foods and nutrition).

Wildlife

Exhibitors must comply with State and Federal Laws.

It is illegal to possess threatened or endangered wildlife, or the feather, nests, or eggs of non-game birds. Game birds and game animals taken legally during an open season may be used.

Class 604 – Wildlife Notebook:

Contents pertain to some phase, results, story, or information about the wildlife project

Class 605 – Wildlife Educational Display:

Must be directly related to something learned in the wildlife project.

Class 607 – Forestry Tri-Fold size 3'X4'. (See County rule books for suggested exhibits).

Shooting

Class 608 – Shooting Sports, Tri-Fold size 3'X4'. (See County rule books for suggested exhibits).
