

Open Class Division

Judging: Refer To The Schedule In Fair Paper

General Rules

1. All entrants must be current residents of the State of Kansas.
2. Classes are open to all ages.
3. No exhibitor may enter more than one item in any one class, with the exception of photography.
4. Entries must be the product of one individual, rather than a group, club, or family.
5. All entries must be made and checked in by 11:00a.m. On Thursday.
6. All entries must be accompanied by an official open class entry tag, available at the fair office or from the division superintendent on fair day.
7. Exhibits will be judged by 4-H judges, using 4-H standards.
8. A maximum of three price ribbons, first, second, and third, will be awarded in each class. Ribbons will be awarded at the judge's discretion. Those not earning a first, second, or third place ribbon will receive a participation ribbon.
9. All food entries will be sold with 4-H entries following judging.
10. All clothing, quilts, knitting, and crocheting should be entered in clear plastic bags for protection.
11. Exhibitors should follow 4-H guidelines and rules listed with each class.
12. With the exception of foods, all entries will be displayed during the fair and released with 4-H entries after 3p.m. on Saturday. Entries should be picked up by exhibitors or their representatives by 4 p.m.
13. The fair association assumes no responsibility for loss or damage to items exhibited at the fair.
14. Items in parenthesis listed after class description is the size or number of items to be provided to be judged.
15. Premium money or prizes are not awarded.
